Students who have little or no background in music theory will be required to pass MUSI 1183 Music Fundamentals with a minimum grade of B as a prerequisite to enrollment in Music Theory I. Music department requirements include piano proficiency. Those students who enter with little or no piano background may be required to pass (with a minimum grade of C) up to four hours of piano class (Class Piano I, II, III, and IV—MUSC 1161, 1171, 2161 and 2171).
